It is these challenging conversations and opportunities to think critically and creatively that help to ensure our vision and purpose continually drive improvements in what we offer to the children.

Next week, we are holding our Autumn Term Parent Teacher Consultations. I do hope as many of you as possible are able to attend, as class teachers will be going through important learning information and next steps for your children. We will be trialling a new approach to these consultations, with all meetings taking place in the hall. Part of the rationale behind this is to help improve time-keeping, so that all meetings start and finish on time.
