Message from the Headteacher

It was fantastic to see so many of you at the 'Meet The Teacher' events this week. If you weren't able to attend, don't fret – all of the information has been uploaded to the 'Parents and Carers' area on the school website and I know the PTA reps have been very helpful in disseminating the key messages.

Our new home learning routine starts next week, with home learning tasks going live on the website on Thursday. In our bid to use less paper, we are aiming for most of the home learning to be paperless, however do please let your class teacher know if this causes any difficulties. Home learning tasks should be returned to school or completed online by the following Wednesday. After half term, we will be setting up some after school homework clubs for parents and children to come to if they desire.

From next week, all children need to have their PE Kits in school please. As a reminder of my key message from earlier in the week, my expectation is that Key Stage 1 children (Year 1 and Year 2) bring their PE Kits in at the start of every half term, with kits staying in school until the holiday when they will be sent home for washing. For Key Stage 2 children, we expect kits to be brought in for the week on Monday morning - we will send them home for washing on Fridays.
