Reception

PSED

The children in Reception will spend time settling in and getting to know each other and the staff in the school. This term we will sing songs about friendship, kindness and learn how to use our manners. We will listen to stories about different emotions and learn how to share with our friends.

Communication Language and Literacy

We will encourage the children to develop their language skills by talking about their experiences such as weekend activities or special occasions. The children will begin to learn the routines of school and understand our school expectations.

All About Me

Understanding the World

The children will talk about the similarities and differences between Reception and their previous setting. We will talk about our families, languages we speak and places we have visited. We will talk about the importance of plants and look after the selection of plants in the classroom.

Mathematics

This term we will count, recognise numbers in our environment and start to think about accurately counting objects. We will look at 2D shapes and begin to think about measurement.



Physical Development

In PE sessions, we will explore jumping, skipping, hopping, side-stepping and balancing. We will talk about how we move safely during PE.

We will focus on the toilet routine and the importance of proper handwashing.

We will practice putting coats and shoes on independently.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will have many opportunities to use a variety of materials during the school day. We will create self-portraits, collages and Rothko inspired art. The children will have the opportunity to make playdough to use in the classroom. The children will use construction blocks to create their homes and local places.
