Reading

- Reading books will be changed twice a week on Monday and Thursdays. **The book will only be changed if it has been signed.**
- It is important that your child reads and discusses the book they are reading every night, to an adult. **Please ensure that you comment on their reading every night in their planner.**
- We visit our school library once a week.
- Reading volunteers may also come in to do one to one reading during the week – these are organised through the Deputy Head.

Writing

- Children will be learning to use a variety of different genres in their writing: stories with familiar settings, stories from other cultures, stories from fantasy settings and traditional tales.
- The children will also look at non-fiction writing. This includes : instructions, lists, labels, letter writing and information texts.
- Children will also look at poetry.
- All writing is based on recommended books for Year 2 or our Topic, which are linked.

Speaking and Listening

- This is just as important as reading and writing.
- Drama and role play is important in developing speaking and listening skills. It can also inspire writing.

Maths

- Children will use hands on concrete apparatus and lots of discussion to enable them to understand.
- Times tables are important and the children need to know the 2, 5 and 10 times tables as well as the corresponding division facts by heart.
- SATs – don't panic!
