Please encourage the children to create a word analysis (see example) grid for each of their spellings.

The SPAG challenge is that each of their example sentences should aim to include **one relative clause** (a feature which they have been working on in class this week.)

Examples of relative clause:

The deep caves, *which once sheltered Neanderthals from the savage Ice Age conditions*, are now empty.

Simon, *whose teeth had fallen out the previous day*, gave a gummy smile.

See the examples to the right of relative pronouns to help with the construction of relative clauses.

PRONOUNS	USAGE
WHO	refers to people (subject)
WHOM	refers to people (objects of the verb)
WHOSE	refers to possessions
WHICH	refers to animals and objects.
THAT	refers to people, things, and animals
WHERE	refers to places
WHEN	refers to time
WHY	refers to reasons
WHAT	refers to things
